




Dear friends of Sojourner House,

HE SOJOURNER HOUSE MOMS summer camps are a vital and fun aspect of the Sojourner House mission to support mothers and their children as they transition to a healthy and substance-free life together. This past summer - just like every summer children of Sojourner House MOMS clients were given an opportunity to learn and grow while enjoying all that summer in Pittsburgh has to offer. Four days each week in July and August, the children participated in academic programs, physical activity, artistic projects, and a weekly field trip. Sponsored by the Homeless Children's Education Fund (HCEF), the summer camp was staffed by community volunteers and teachers from the Pittsburgh Public Schools. Favorite activities of the campers were trips to the Pittsburgh Zoo and the Carnegie **Science Center**, cooling off at the spray park, and creating masterpieces with the Citiparks Roving Art Cart.
