Sojourner House is seeking a full-time LEAD CLINICAL THERAPIST - ASSISTANT SUPERVISOR ... reporting to the Clinical Supervisor this working-therapist supervisory position helps to support the Clinical Supervisor's duties in the day-to-day services of a "women with children" residential program and is the person in charge of clinical services during the Clinical Supervisor's absence. Responsible for helping to ensure the program's clinical quality and assisting the Program Manager with developing a therapeutic milieu. Providing clinical support to direct care staff. In collaboration with the Clinical Supervisor the position provides some direction and oversight to the clinical staff including Trauma Informed Care and Collaborative Documentation trainings.

REQUIRES:

- MS or BS degree from an accredited college in Social Work, Psychology, Counseling, Chemical Dependency, Nursing (with a clinical specialty in administration or human services), or related field required. Full certifications as an addictions counselor, such as ASAM, and/or LSW preferred.
- At least 2 years of counseling experience in a health or human service agency which includes 1 year of working directly with the chemically dependent.
- Current/valid Driver's License and ability to drive a 12 passenger van as needed to escort residents within the East End and surrounding communities.
- Understanding of dynamics of substance abuse, maternal addiction, and recovery methods.
- Ability to lead and coach staff; and contribute to a positive, team-oriented, work environment.
- Advanced interpersonal, written, and verbal communication skills to establish and maintain good will and good working relationships with staff, clients, family members, other service providers, volunteers, board members, and community representatives.
- Excellent time management skills.
- Ability to provide case management, diagnostic assessments, develop treatment plans, make and track referrals for health/behavioral health services; and conduct individual, family, and group counseling sessions.
- Knowledge of community resources, e.g., DPW, food banks, & family education/recreation.
- Cultural sensitivity and the ability to maintain professional level confidentiality.
- Full-time salaried position, i.e. Monday – Friday, 8:30 AM —4:30 PM, plus on-call and some required non-traditional hours. Flexibility/open availability a must.

SPECIAL CRITERIA:

- Because of program treatment philosophy, persons identified with - or who have been diagnosed with - an alcohol or other drug dependence must be abstinent for at least two years prior to employment and remain abstinent throughout employment. All candidates must be willing to adhere to the Substance Abuse/Drug Free Workplace policy including pre-employment screening.
- Ability to acquire Act 33/34 & FBI clearances (employer reimbursed - after contingent job offer.)
- Must obtain annual TB (PPD) testing (employer reimbursed - after hire.)
- Must attend and participate in all required training (after hire.)
